**U2 love JSDB's latest ... 32-Year Old
McCartney/Stubblefield Connection revealed ...
Courtney Goes To Court, JSDB assigned to monitor
her drug use, "Kid" Mankowitz to film entire
clusterfuck for future release**

This is the week that was in matters musical...

1964, four lads from Liverpool known as The Beatles make their live American TV debut on *The Ed Sullivan Show*, reaching the eyes and ears of over 70 million viewers, the largest television audience ever recorded at the time ... the show receives over 50,000 requests for tickets...Two tickets go to future **JSDB** members Dennis Arnold Stubblefield and Randy Cade who wind up being removed from the theatre after waving large hand-lettered placards at The Beatles that read "Welcome to America, Dave Clark V" and "John, *FUCK YOU in advance* for Yoko!"

1967, working on a tip, British police raid a party at Redlands, the English estate of Keith Richards, searching for illegal drugs ... police find amphetamine pills in singer Mick Jagger's coat and charge him with possession ... Richards is charged with allowing his home to be used for drug-taking, and a third guest is charged with heroin possession ... Richards spends one night in jail, Jagger gets two ... American garage band, **The JSDB** show their support for the Stones by releasing an EP of Jagger-Richards material including "I'm Alright", "19th Nervous Breakdown" and "Paint It, Black". Mick Jagger immediately denounces the record as "*drek...well-intentioned, but drek nonetheless*". Keith Richards was far more generous with his comments, calling **The JSDB** "my favourite new American band" and hinted that they would be asked to open for the Stones during the Fall World Tour. When asked about this arrangement Mick Jagger sneered, "Absolutely no way. Keith must *still* be stoned. We've already got The Jefferson Airplane to open for us...and those blokes can ACTUALLY PLAY thier instruments." Randy Cade fired back from **the JSDB** camp: "Mick Jagger can EAT MY ASS! We did a *good job* on the EP!! In fact, our version of "I'm Alright" is BETTER than their original version, and recorded better as well! AND the Jefferson Fucking Airplane are a bunch of has-been Hippies whose records sound like animals mating with humans! **Fuck** those guys!"

1972, former Beatle Paul McCartney's new band Wings, featuring his wife Linda and former Moody Blues singer Denny Laine, among others, plays its first concert at Nottingham University in the UK ...Paul performs in a T-Shirt presented to him by Dennis Arnold Stubblefield, lead vocalist of the opening act **The JSDB**, which reads "Yeah, Linda can't sing or play but at least she's not FUCKING YOKO!!". After the

performance, Paul and Dennis share a laugh about their initial contact in 1964 (see above).

1975, Cher's eponymous TV show debuts a year after her divorce from Sonny Bono ... the premiere episode guest stars Elton John, Bette Midler, comedian Flip Wilson and last-second addition, San Francisco pre-punkers **The JSDB**. Cher's exposed navel generates much press, but not nearly as much as **The JSDB** garnered as bassist Craig Patterson and singer Dennis Arnold Stubblefield are caught on camera drunkenly urinating from the lighting grid onto Elton John's balding head. Guitarist Randy Cade's off-camera shouting racial epithets during Flip Wilson's segment are aired, and as this is a first for American television ... the show will last only one season...WHICH Cade later points out, is the *same number of keys* that Cher can actually sing in.

1981, *Dark Side of the Moon*, Pink Floyd's eighth LP, becomes the longest-charting album ever at 402 consecutive weeks in the Top 200 Albums chart, beating *Somebody's Gonna Get Their Head Kicked In Tonight*, **The JSDB's** 1972 live album which lasted 401 weeks on Billboard's chart ... Pink Floyd's album will enjoy a resurgence years later, when someone with too much time on his hands realizes that when the CD is synced to *The Wizard of Oz*, there are a number of musical and lyrical coincidences ... the band denies that the album and film are connected in any way whatsoever, and since VCRs and CD players had yet to become readily available when the album was recorded in 1973, it appears to be no more than coincidence..."Kid" Mankowitz, head of JSDB Security and noted rock historian agrees with the members of Floyd, "Nah, that Wizard of Oz thing is bullshit. **The JSDB** actually were the first band to sync up one of their records (1983's *Your Children Are Fat and We Are Hungry*) to another medium (*the film "Rolling Thunder" starring William DeVane and Tommy Lee Jones*). We usta get powerstoned on the tour bus and watch that damn movie over and over....Cade even wrote a song that was inspired by one of Tommy Lee Jones' lines.."Gonna Kill a Buncha People", and I thought the band should release it as a single. But those assholes never listened to me."

1982, the 300-pound marble slab that marks the grave of former Lynyrd Skynyrd singer Ronnie Van Zant is stolen in Orange Park, Florida ... it is recovered by police two weeks later in a rehearsal space recently vacated by shock-rockers **The JSDB** in Anaheim, CA. In large letters written with a Magic Marker below the carved memorial "Ronnie, Never To Be Forgotten" are the words "Hey maybe you shouldn't have forgotten TO CHECK THE GAS, SKY KING!"

1986, in an odd pop-culture pairing, Culture Club singer Boy George guest stars on an episode of the popular TV show *The A-Team*, which stars Mr. T, among others ... in the episode, Boy is mistakenly booked as country singer Cowboy George at one of the toughest dance halls in the West ... Culture Club mimes their performances ("Keep-A-Knockin'", "Surfin' Bird"), which were actually played by aging punks **The JSDB**, who

were removed from the Warner Bros. lot after their racial taunts and banana-tossing enraged Mr. T. and his entourage.

1997, U2 announces its upcoming Popmart Tour from where else? K-Mart, of course ... The band's press conference is held in the lingerie department of a Manhattan K-Mart, Guitarist The Edge tells reporters, "We believe in kitsch. That's what we are into at the moment...that, and the new **JSDB** CD "*We Have Eaten Your Children, Now Where Are The Grandparents?*" ... the "King of Pop," Michael Jackson, and his wife Debbie Rowe welcome their first child at Cedars-Sinai Medical Center in Los Angeles ... the child is unexplainably named Dennis Arnold Jackson II...

2000, during a performance by the Isley Brothers dubbed the Valentine's Super Love Jam at the L.A. Sports Arena, an LAPD officer shoots and kills a 24-year-old man who has allegedly wounded three people near a concession stand ... though the performers and audience have no idea what has transpired, the show is eventually canceled just before a scheduled "Comeback Set" by **The JSDB**, who were slated to premiere cuts from their latest Indy release "*Grandma's Tits and Other Wrong Stuff*".

2004, Bassist Nick Oliveri is fired from Queens of the Stone Age ... "He's a tornado, and a tornado just destroys and goes on to the next city. I'm in the tornado cleanup crew, and all I ever see is his detritus and I'm sick of it," says *QOTSA* front man Josh Homme...Randy Cade and Craig Patterson of **The JSDB** release a statement, "TELL us about it, *ya fucking wimp!* We have been living in a tornado of our own (evidentially a reference to their lead singer Dennis Arnold Stubblefield) for 26 YEARS, asshole! Get some BALLS!"

2005, Courtney Love pleads no contest to charges of her alleged assault on musician Kristin King ... she is ordered by a Los Angeles court to take anger-management classes, pay a \$1,000 fine, perform 100 hours of community service and subject herself to 40 hours of verbal and aural abuse by members of Cryptopunk LA scenster band, **The JSDB**. Lead Singer Dennis Arnold Stubblefield outlined his plan for Courtney.. "What I'm gonna do is ram a wine cork in her left ear and then belch as loud as I can into her right ear....until she passes out, then I'm gonna take a dump on her. It's what Kurt Cobain would've wanted." When asked what his role would be in the Courtney intervention, JSDB Avatar "Kid" Mankowitz said, "Are you fuckin' kiddin'? I'm gonna videotape the whole thing, the entire 40 hours, edit it down and sell it on eBay. Working for **The** fucking **JSDB** didn't exactly leave me set up for my "Golden Years", *ya know what I mean, shithead?*"
